Scenic Drives; Friday & Saturday to leave from Canyonlands Inn in Downtown Moab and also from Red Cliffs Lodge on Mile 14, Hwy. 28 on both days. Departure time on scheduled drives is listed, and approx. time to take drives

is available on handout lists. **Drives are also posted on a separate page on Moab Home Page on web site.** Time of drive depends on # of cars and number of stops made. **Each car is responsible for any Entry Fees to State or National Parks.**

(Note: cars will line up at NW corner of Center & Main St. on North side of Canyonlands Inn and in East Parking lot at Red Cliffs Lodge prior to each drive. Instructions will be given before departure.) Look for drive leader holding a sign.
